

# AVIAN INFLUENZA

WHAT	DETAIL
<b>Secure Premises</b>	Repair/Install fencing/gates. Appropriate signage.
<b>Examine all facilities.</b>	Repair all poultry houses to prevent wild bird/animal entry.
<b>Update General Movement Protocols</b>	Normal/Increased Awareness/Infected Zone
<b>Map current employees</b>	Who works where and crosses paths (cohabitates) with other employees?
<b>Establish Service Crew Biosecurity Protocols</b>	Crew travel/movement history. On farm biosecurity. Arrival/departure logistics. Information sharing.
<b>Establish Outside work Crew Biosecurity Protocols</b>	Electricians, Plumbers, Sales People, etc.
<b>Establish Manure Protocols</b>	Who hauls? Where? When? -see general movement protocols
<b>Stockpile supplies</b>	Biosecurity Gear
	Cleaning and Disinfectant supplies
	Testing/sampling supplies
<b>PPE Equipment</b>	Order? Select key employees. Medical sign off. Fit test.

# AVIAN INFLUENZA

WHAT	DETAIL
<b>Euthanasia Equipment</b>	Identify. Purchase? Use agreements? CO2 supplies.
<b>Establish/Reaffirm Relationships</b>	Communicate with local elected officials, sheriff, suppliers, neighbors, etc.
<b>Police employee/contractor personal bird restriction policy</b>	Reaffirm with all employees and contractors. Discuss other family members bird ownership.
<b>Hatchery Delivery Protocol</b>	Biosecurity for vehicles, equipment, chick tray/baskets, service crews/people, etc.
<b>Evaluate company policies for selling small lots of birds or hatching eggs.</b>	Prevent any possible exposure.
<b>Employee travel policy</b>	Inform employees of outbreak locations and discourage travel to such.
<b>Limit on-farm deliveries</b>	Consider central delivery and pick-up locations for UPS, FedEx, etc.
<b>Limit poultry house/processing access</b>	Only essential employees. No visitors, children, pets, etc.
<b>Examine all facilities.</b>	Repair all poultry houses to prevent wild bird/animal entry.

# AVIAN INFLUENZA

WHAT	DETAIL
<b>Secure additional Workforce</b>	For when needed in crisis situation
<b>Temporary housing</b>	Available locations for additional crews when needed
<b>Identify medical personnel</b>	Physical health and mental caregivers for when needed.
<b>Identify potential Clean/Infected transfer zone</b>	Identify location that has dual traffic access to establish pick-up and drop off sites for samples, supplies, etc. Reference general movement protocols.
<b>Ensure "clean" corn source</b>	Insist on covered storage and delivery vehicles from suppliers.
